Strategic Goal 2

Discovery time at MBS is an opportunity for students to engage in hands on learning experiences that are linked to learning areas, needs and/or interests.

Purpose of Discovery Time

The purpose of MBS Discovery time is to:

- Learning through hands on exploration
- Promote learning to work together in small groups and collaboration
- Promote thinking and questioning
- Develop independence and confidence
- Encourage decision making, risk taking and promote student agency
- Engage students in learning
- Have teacher involvement and questioning during play to deepen thinking & questioning
- Offer opportunities to support students with their learning needs such as fine motor skills and communication
- Develop a child's ability to question to deepen their understanding of the world around them
