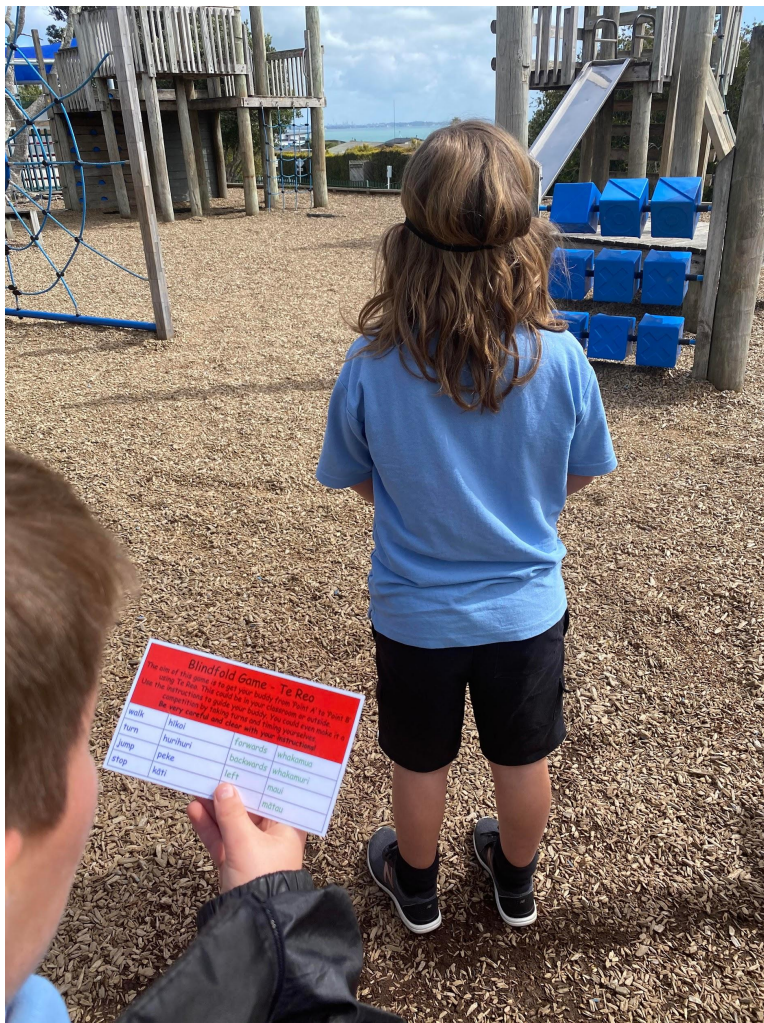

## Giving directions in Te Reo 'Blindfold game'

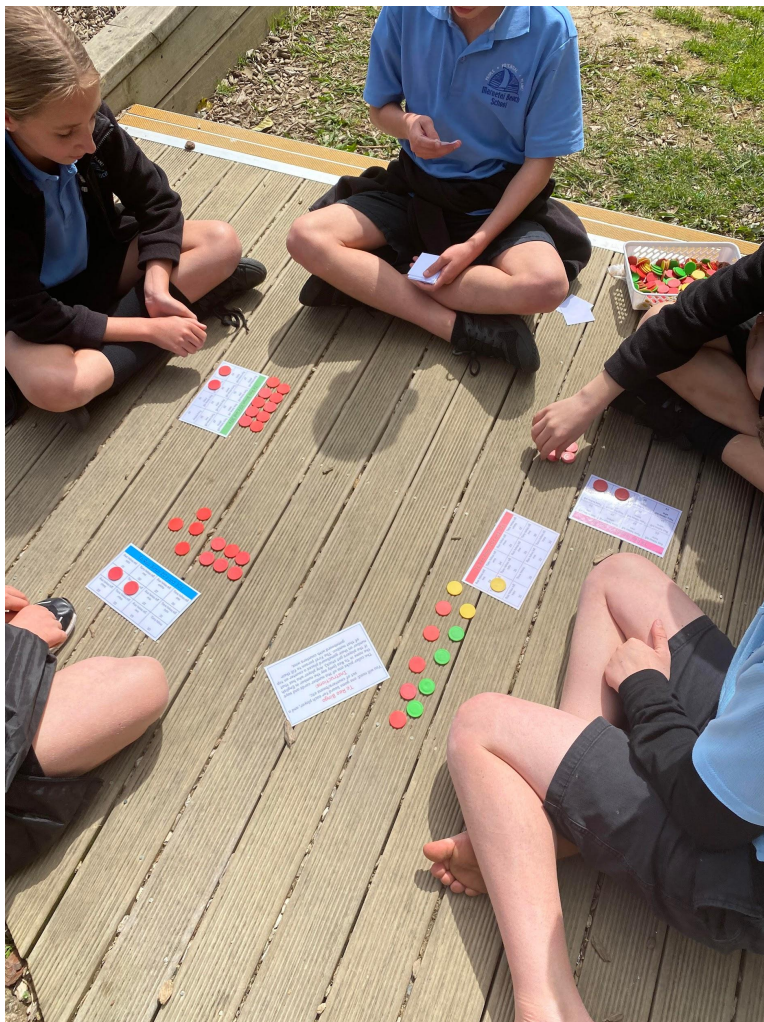
**Blindfold Game - Te Reo**

stop	hāhi	right	mauau

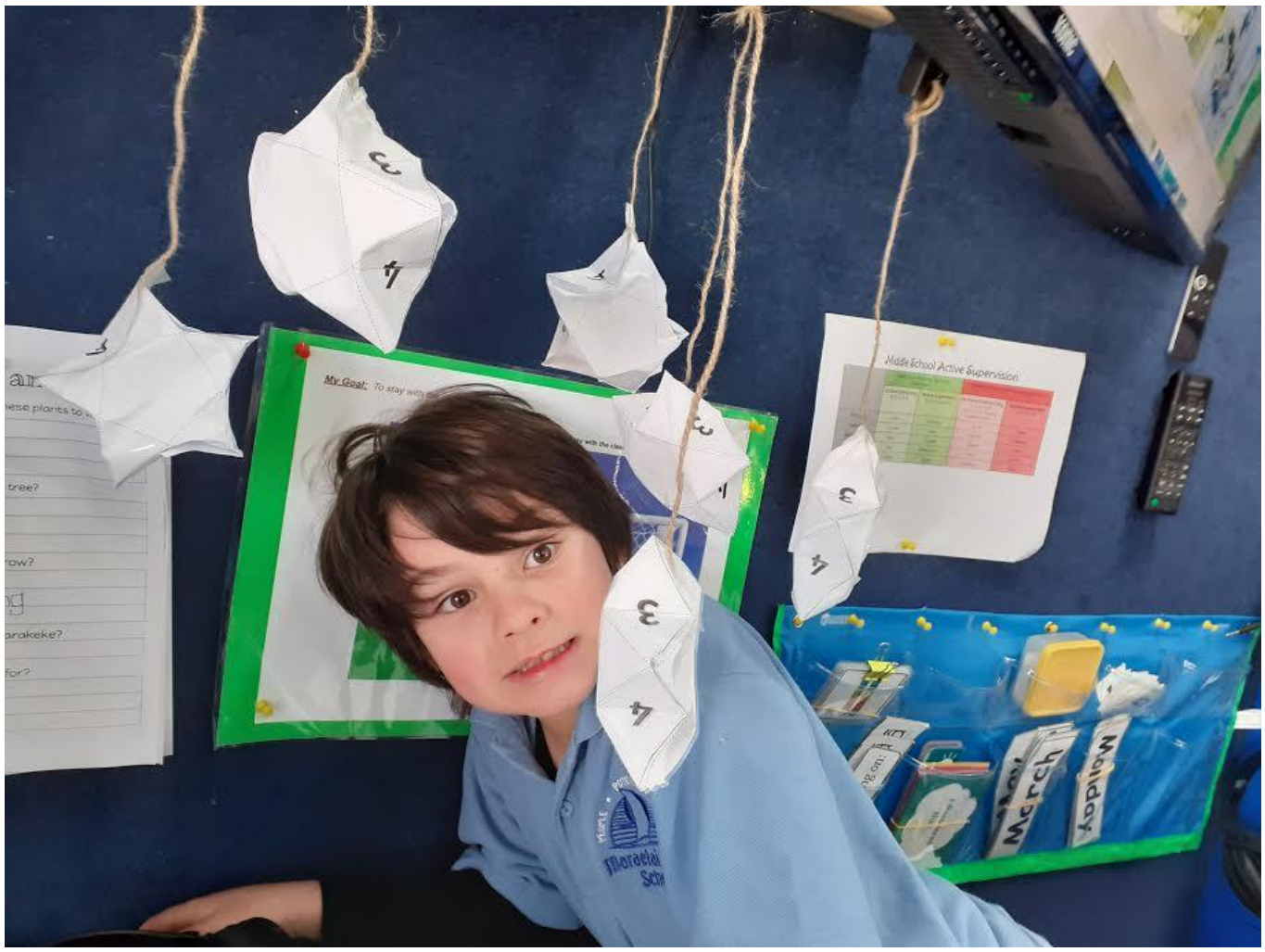


## Learning numbers in Te Reo 1-50

(Caller says a number in Te Reo and the other players find the number in numeral form)



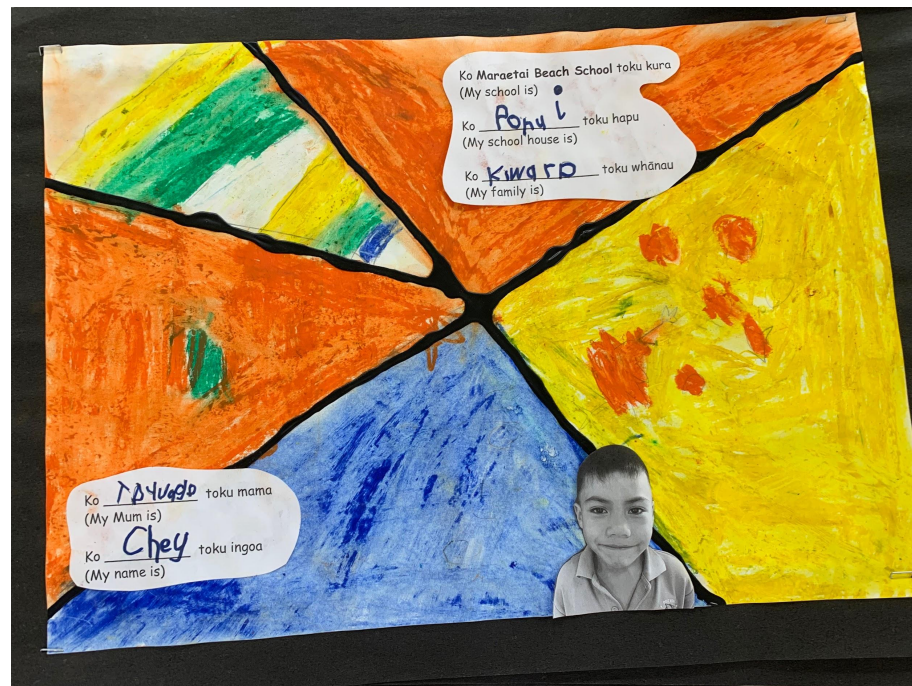

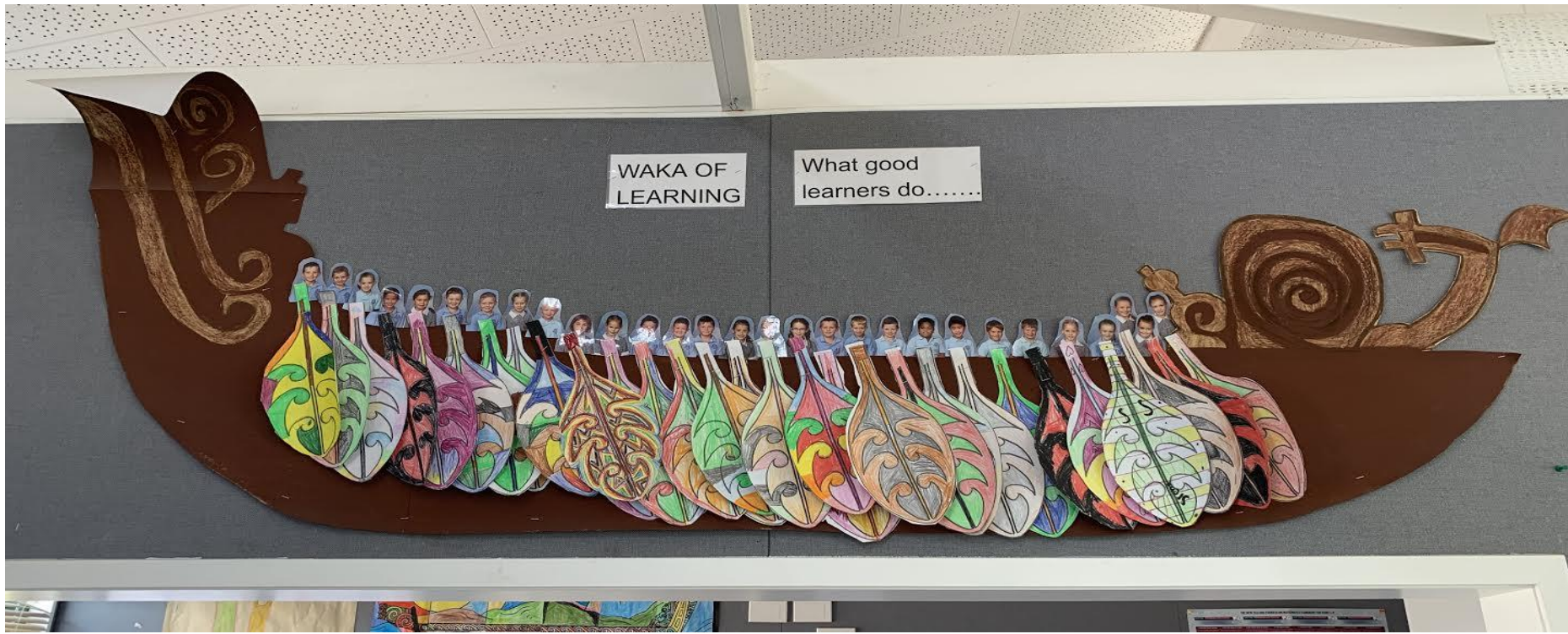
